

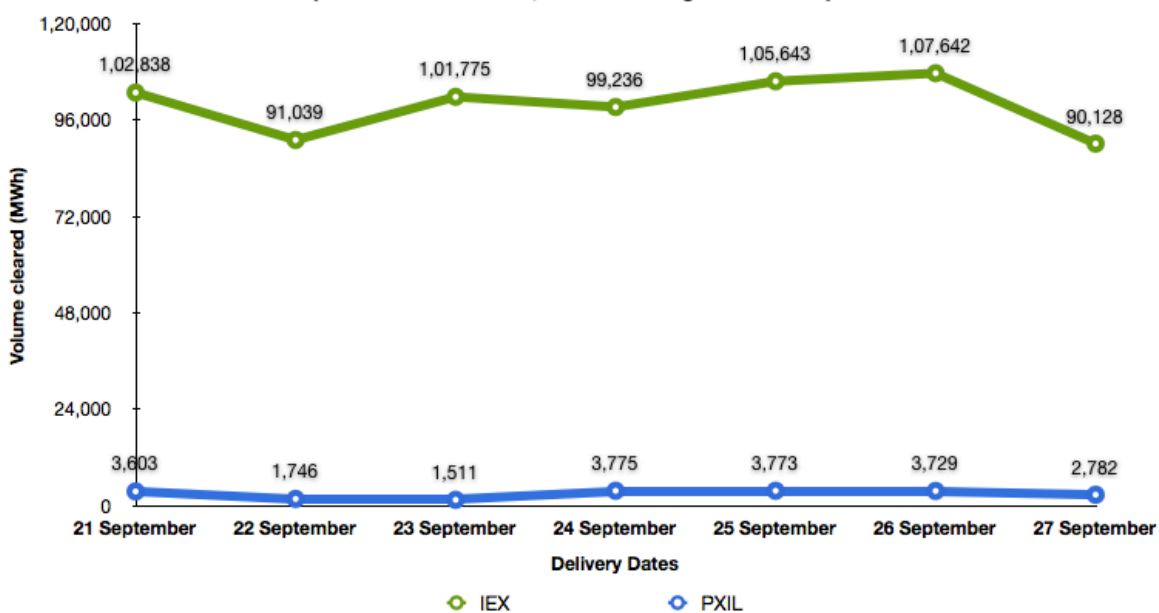
Punjab to implement Time-of-Day tariff for industries

The Punjab State Power Corporation (PSPCL) will implement the Time-of-Day tariff structure for industrial units from next month. The structure will be applicable to large supply industrial category from next month till March 2014.

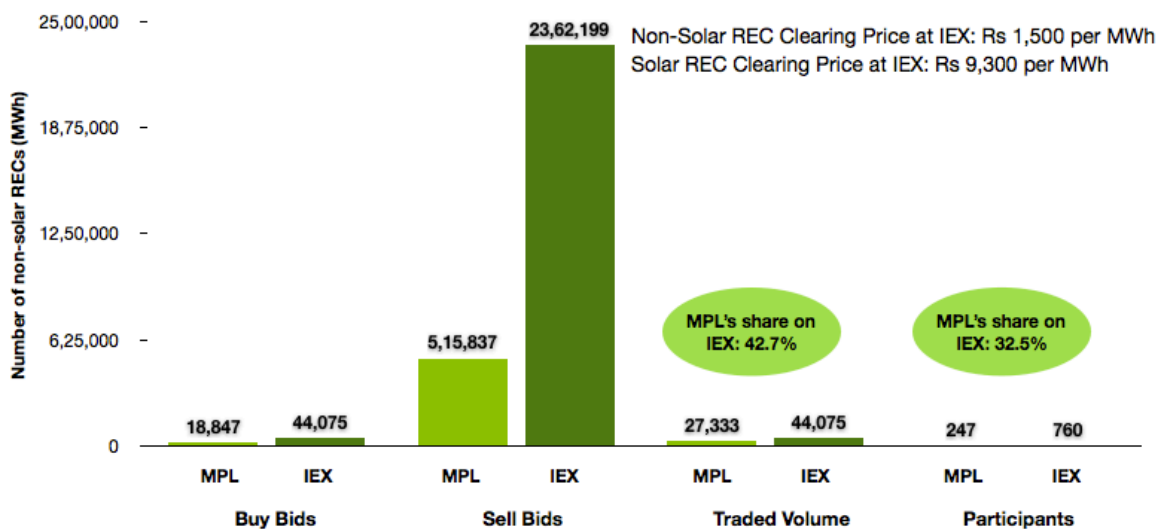
These industrial units will be supplied electricity at a rebate of Re 1 per kWh on the normal tariff on power consumed during off-peak hours of 10 PM to 6 AM.

“We always demanded that ToD tariff should be implemented as it is beneficial for the industrial sector. There will be a positive effect on the viability of the units as we will be get power at discounted rate,” Northern India Induction Furnace Association President K K Garg told Hindu Business Line.
