

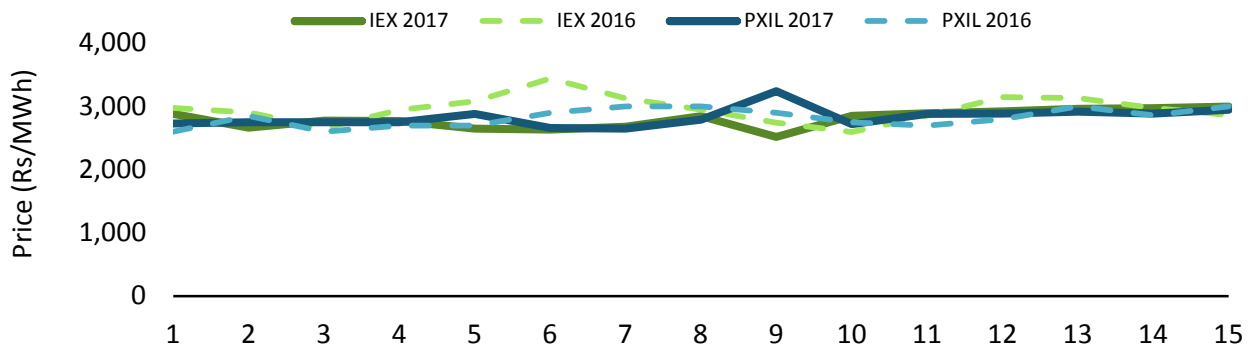

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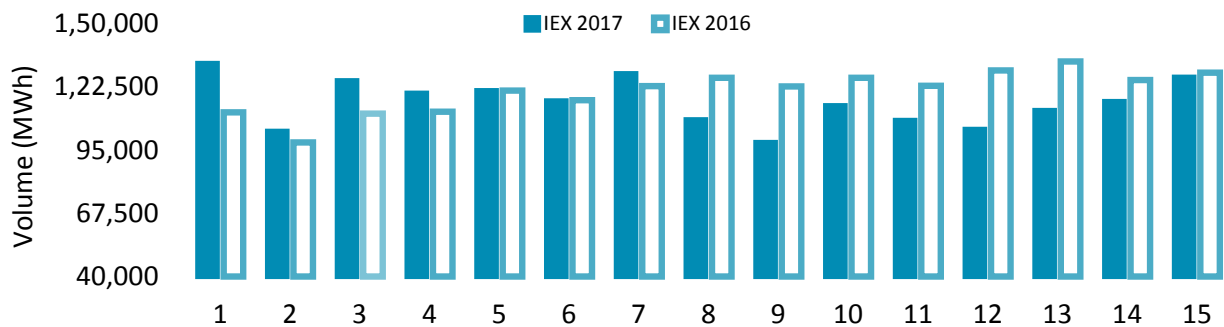

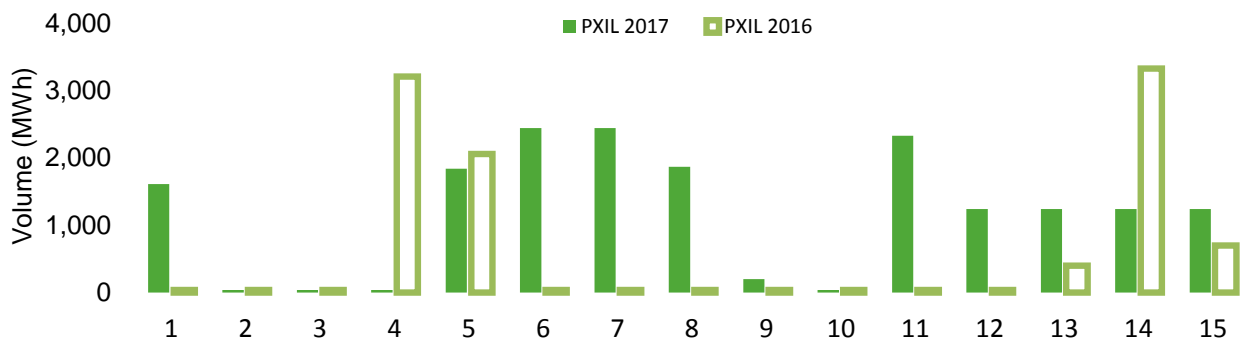
Year-on-year price comparison of power traded on IEX and PXIL (1-15 April)



Year-on-year volume comparison of power traded on IEX (1-15 April)

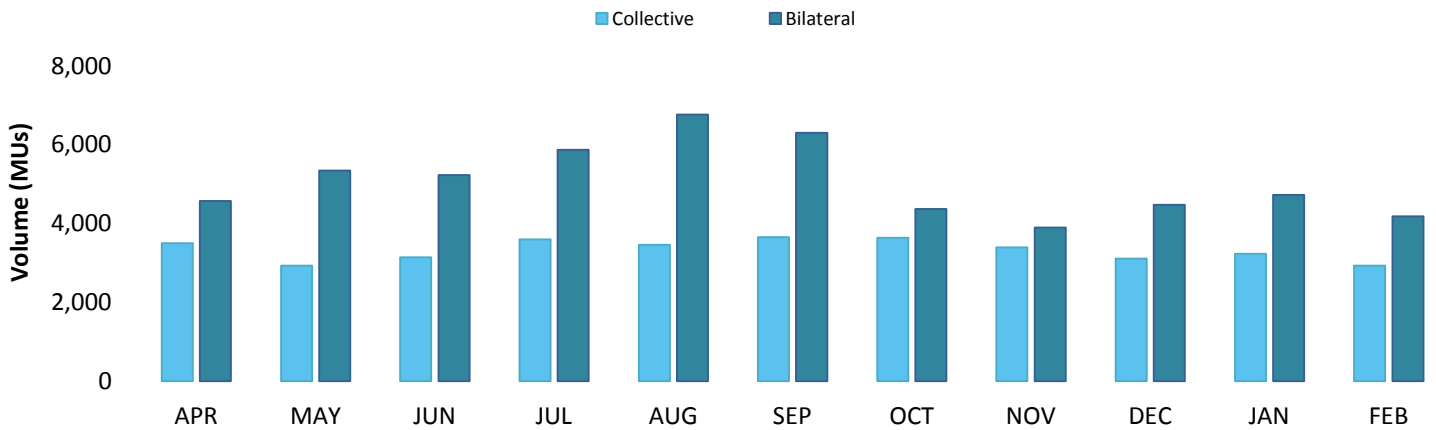
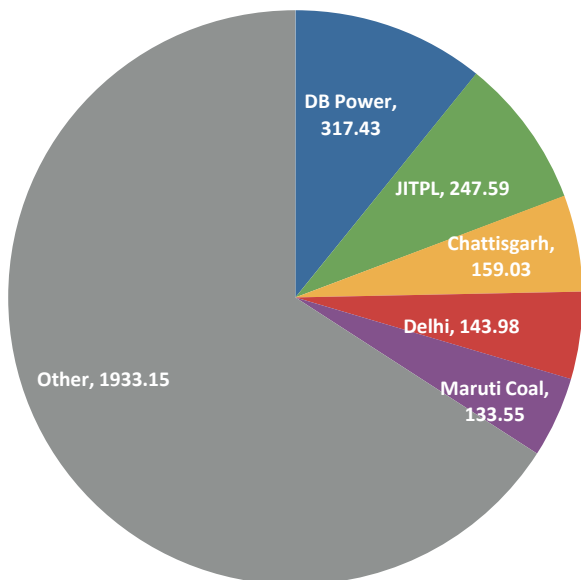
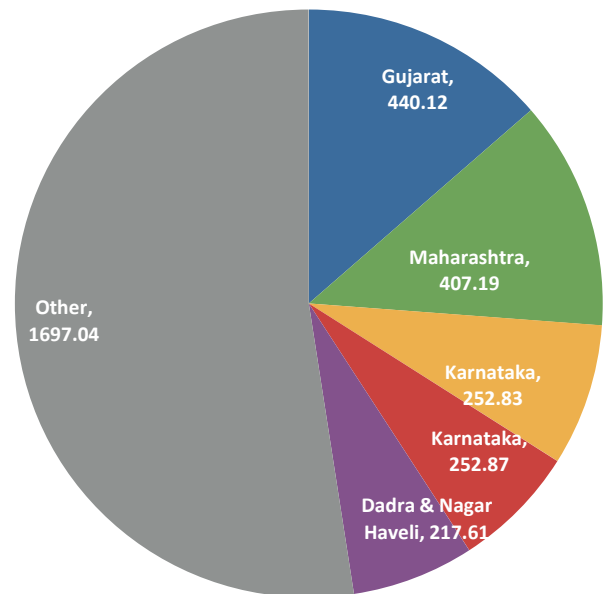

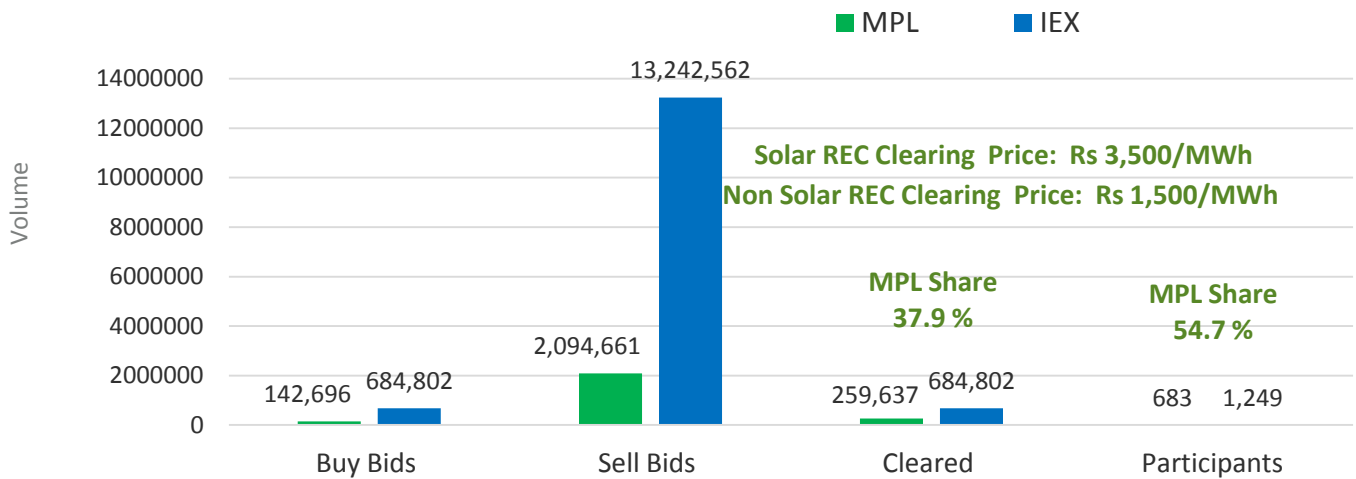

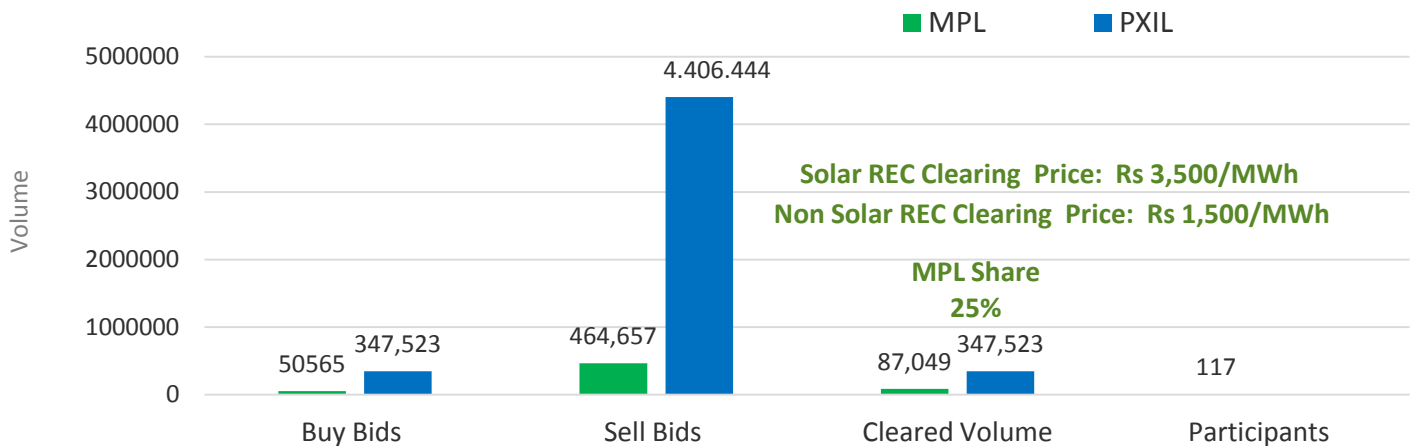

BHEL commissions 2nd unit of Yeramarus plant in Karnataka

BHEL has commissioned the second 800 MW unit of Yeramarus thermal plant in Karnataka

Powergrid completes 765 kV Wardha-Nizamabad line

It will facilitate import of power from Western Region mainly Chattisgarh for which LTA has been granted to Telangana

Mizoram becomes 27th state to join UDAY

Mizoram has become the 27th state to join UDAY scheme meant for revival of debt-stressed discoms which will help it get overall benefits of Rs 198 crore during the period of turnaround

PTC Energy commissions wind projects in Karnataka, Andhra

PTC Energy Ltd today announced commissioning of five wind power projects with an aggregate capacity of 238.8 megawatts in Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka

Centre's green nod to Rs 9,747-crore Khurja Power Project in Uttar Pradesh

The 1320 MW Khurja Super Thermal Power Station in Bulandshahr district is one such station being set up for supply of power to the beneficiaries of northern region and UP

To cut tariff, government wants to link coal bids to lower charges in PPAs

The government has proposed to bid coal from state-run CIL to those power generators that agree to cut the supply charges quoted in their PPAs

Vikram Solar commissions 130 Mw solar project for NTPC in Rajasthan

The project developed under the State Specific Bundling Scheme (for bundling with thermal power from NTPC Singrauli Thermal power station) with the grid at Bhadla Solar Park Phase-II

Madhya Pradesh: Surmounting AT&C losses negating effect of cheap power

The state took a decision to bring about investor-friendly policies to encourage private sector investment in the power sector

Nepal to import electricity worth NRS 15 bn from India

The NEA has so far imported electricity worth NRS 9.68 billion from India in the first nine months of FY 16-17

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TPREL commissions 100 MW wind farm in AP

Tata Power Renewable Energy, the renewable energy arm of Tata Power, commissioned a 100 MW wind farm at Nimbagallu in Andhra Pradesh

Tripura set to supply extra 60 MW of power to Bangladesh

Tripura has been supplying 100 MW of electricity to Bangladesh since March 23, 2016, in addition to the 500 MW the country is receiving from West Bengal since 2013

R-Power to seal Bangla project today

R-Power will on Monday seal the PPA with Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) to get the \$1-billion first phase of its proposed power project and liquid gas import terminal in Bangladesh

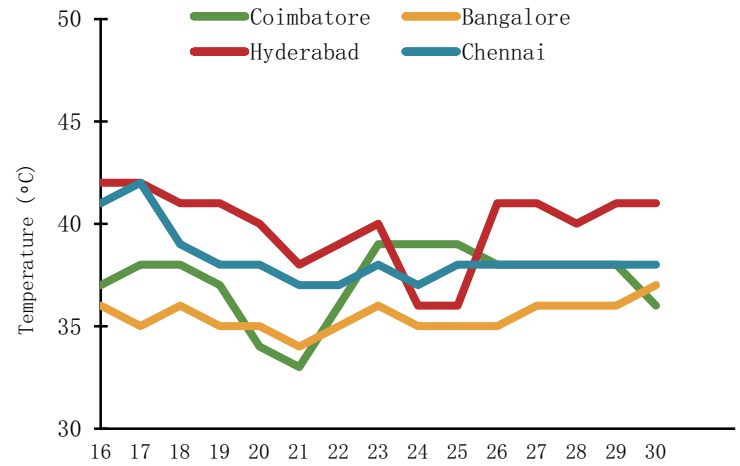
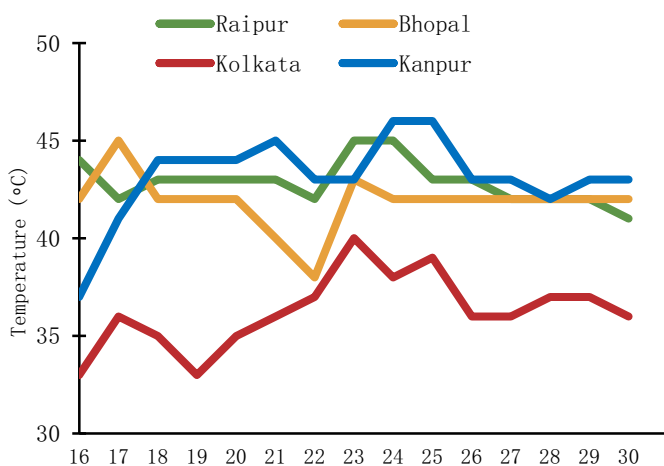
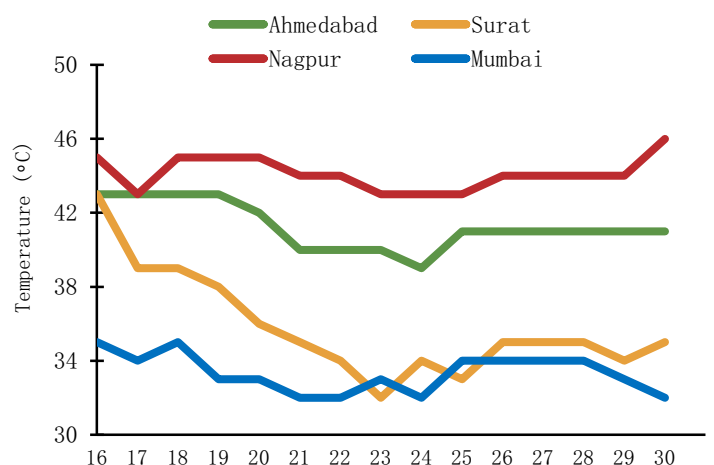
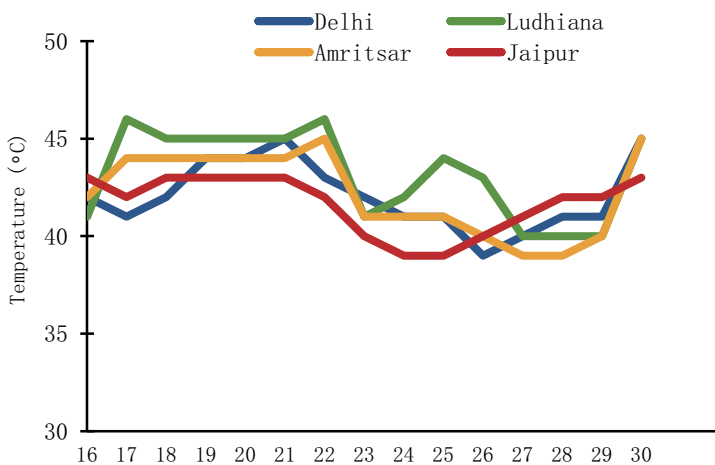
Karnataka ERC revises tariff for Grid Interactive Megawatt Scale Power Plants for FY 18

The price discovery for solar power procurement in FY13 through bids was in the range of Rs.7.94 to Rs.8.50 per unit. The same in FY14 was in the range of Rs. 6.66 to Rs.8.05 per unit and in FY15 it was in the range of Rs.6.71 to Rs.7.12 per unit. The rate determined by the commission as per its order dated 30th July is being revised through this order. The Commission found it necessary to revise as Media reports show that some States have received bids from developers to supply solar power around Rs 4.00 per unit.

The commission determined tariff of Rs 4.36 per unit for all new grid connected MW scale solar PV plants entering into PPA on or after 1st April 2017 but before 1st April 2018. The tariff is also applicable for Solar PV plants for which PPAs were entered into before 1st April to 31st March, 2017 but are not commissioned within the specified commercial operation date (COD) and achieve COD during the period from 1st April, 2017 to 31st March 2018.
